DAY 1

Arrive Singapore

Tour begins: 5:00 PM, Raffles Singapore. A transfer is included from Singapore's Changi International Airport to the historic Raffles Singapore, a landmark of colonial elegance and the good life since it opened in 1887; the hotel boasts an iconic reputation as one of the city's most luxurious retreats.

Join us for a private welcome reception and dinner in this legendary setting tonight, with a taste of the hotel's famous signature cocktail, the Singapore Sling. **Meals D**

DAY 2

Singapore Sights

Singapore blends tradition with technology, evoking images of a futuristic setting with a nod to its storied past. Explore the sights, past and present, on a guided walking tour of the colonial district followed by a traditional bumboat ride through history on a cruise along the Singapore River.

Discover the city's distinctive architecture on a sightseeing drive with an informative guide before returning to your hotel for time at leisure. **Meals BL**

DAY 3

Futuristic Gardens by the Bay

Start the day with a conservation-inspired lecture by a local expert before embarking on a visit to Gardens by the Bay, themed gardens "where wonder blooms" in a 250-acre fantasy land of space age biodomes, high-tech super trees and whimsical sculptures. Your guided tour includes time to wander amidst flowers that thrive in dry Mediterranean climates around the world in the Garden Dome and through rainforest vegetation in its tropical Cloud Forest, complete with a waterfall. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure, exploring the gardens on your own or returning to your hotel in the heart of the city. Easy to navigate, Singapore is a compact city and its restaurants tempt with culinary creations difficult to resist. **Meals B**

DAY 4

Fly to the island of Java in Indonesia

A morning flight brings you to Yogyakarta, Indonesia; step off the plane, and you'll find yourself in a cultural hub of puppetry, arts, sandstone temples and jeweled palaces that speak volumes about Indonesia's "city of soul and traditions." Have lunch at a local restaurant, then travel through the countryside to Magelang, where your hotel offers views of the world's largest Buddhist temple. Dinner tonight features traditional entertainment. **Meals BLD**

DAY 5

Sunrise at Borobudur Temple

Join us at dawn to visit the 9th-century Borobudur Temple, a colossal Buddhist temple, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its sculpted bas-relief panels depict the teachings of the Buddha and are allegedly designed to guide “the faithful” on a journey of spiritual enlightenment. After breakfast, explore Candirejo village by horse cart or on foot, as you choose. Spend the afternoon as you please, before joining us for a lecture on the historic kingdoms of Java. Dinner is at leisure tonight. **Meals BLD**

DAY 6

Yogyakarta & Prambanan Temples

Ride a bicycle-powered becak to the royal sultan palace complex in the Kraton of Yogyakarta, where the sultan and his family live today. After lunch, tour the Prambanan Temple complex, built in the 10th century and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Have dinner at a local restaurant before an open-air 200-person ballet performance, complete with VIP seating, traditional music, stunning choreography, and Prambanan Temple as a breathtaking backdrop. **Meals BLD**

DAY 7

Fly to Bali, an island paradise

Fly early this morning to a Balinese island paradise steeped in flowered blessings and spectacular natural beauty. Touch down for a drive to Ubud, stopping for lunch and a visit to the Ubud Monkey Forest in the village of Padangtegal. Arrive at your tranquil resort late this afternoon, where you'll dine as you please this evening. **Meals BD**

DAY 8

Village life & landscapes in Ubud

Experience a taste of daily life on a walking tour of a local village. Have lunch in the village before visiting the serene village temple with an offering. The rest of the day is free to explore as you like, or join a local guide for an optional hike through the rice fields. **Meals BL**

DAY 9

Discover a taste of Ubud

Begin the day with a visit to a local village market before your choice of sightseeing. Attend a cooking class and learn how to make authentic Balinese dishes – alternatively, a museum curator guides you through the ARMA, a renowned Balinese art museum, with an opportunity to meet the owner and founder. The rest of the day is free. **Meals BL**

Its vibrant culture enchants through a strong sense of tradition (such as a visit to Borobudur Temple) and warm hospitality. DAY 10

Fly to Flores Island

Fly midday to the island of Flores for a two-night stay, with lunch upon arrival. Join us for a sundowner, barbecue dinner on the beach with traditional music and dance. **Meals BLD**

DAY 11

Boat ride to the land of the dragons

Cruise to Rinca Island in Komodo National Park* and join a local guide for a walk to see rare Komodo dragons. Take a boat ride to a tropical island, private to Tauck, for lunch and time for snorkeling. An optional motorboat ride to Manta Point offers an opportunity to see manta rays (weather permitting). Dine at a choice of hotel restaurants. **Meals BLD**

DAY 12

Fly to an oceanfront resort in Bali

Fly back to Bali for a two-night stay in Jimbaran Bay. Check into your luxury resort for free time before enjoying a sundowner cocktail and a traditional Balinese Kecak dance performance. Dinner is at leisure tonight. **Meals BL**

DAY 13

Clifftop Uluwatu Temple

This morning, visit clifftop Uluwatu Temple to learn about the important role it plays in Balinese history and culture. Watch for the Macaque monkeys that live here as you gaze out at the views of the sea from this temple set on a rock 230 ft. above the water. Stop at GWK Park to see the Garuda Wisnu (Vishnu) statue before time at leisure. Join us by the pool at your resort for a farewell dinner. **Meals BD**

DAY 14

Journey Home

Tour ends: Denpasar. Fly home anytime. A transfer is included to I Gusti Ngurah Rai International airport from the Four Seasons Resort Bali. Allow three hours for check-in. **Meals B**
